As an Apprentice Highway Maintenance Operative you will work on rural and urban roads to repair damaged surfaces, using hand and power tools and pedestrian plant machinery. Day-to-day tasks include:

- Putting up and removing signage and guarding of highway works
- Preparing, applying, compacting and removing soils, rocks and other materials
- Operating machinery and carrying out routine maintenance on the equipment to make sure it is always fully operational
- Helping with the loading and unloading of vehicles both by hand and by use of specialist equipment
- Taking part in winter maintenance operations
